Geographic Lead Agencies

Geographic Lead Agencies play a vital role within the California Statewide System of Support.

Assembly Bill 1808 (Statutes of 2018) funded the establishment of the California Geographic Lead Agencies (Geo Leads) to build the capacity of county offices of education (COEs) to support local educational agencies (LEAs) and meet the needs of students in California. There are seven Geo Leads housed within nine COEs: Kern County Superintendent of Schools; Placer and Sacramento COEs; Santa Clara COE; Riverside and San Diego COEs; Shasta COE, Sonoma COE, and Tulare COE.

EC52071(f) For any school district in which one or more pupil subgroups meets the criteria for technical assistance for three or more consecutive years, the school district's geographic lead agency shall, in collaboration with the county superintendent of schools, provide technical assistance to the school district. The geographic lead agency shall evaluate whether the assistance of one or more expert lead agencies should be consulted as part of the technical assistance process.
